Seasonal Climate Outlook

October to December 2025

This Seasonal outlook is based on the two-month average value of June and July 2025 of the Central Eastern and South-western Pacific Ocean sea-surface temperature anomalies. The outlook is presented as the 'probability' or chance of the coming rainfall being in one of the three Tercile Classes – Below normal, Normal, and Above normal. The lead time is one month.


Summary

- August rainfall was generally below-normal to near-normal for the country.
- The three-month outlook is "above-normal" across the country.
- ENSO status remains "neutral".



NOAA Satellite prediction showing below the long-term average (brown-shade) for Solomon Islands during the month of August. (Source: NOAA Climate Prediction Center)




SIMS Observed rainfall for the last three months for the country.




ACCES-S — Fortnightly Rainfall Outlook for 20th August to 26th September 2025






Rainfall outlook for the coming fortnight is likely "above-normal" for Temotu, Central Islands, and parts of Malaita and Northwest Guadalcanal; elsewhere, the outlook is "near-normal".

ACCESS-S OUTLOOK - Rainfall Outlook for October to December 2025




The rainfall outlook is very likely to be "above normal" across the country for the next three months.









Current Status of ENSO Currently remains in Neutral Phase (neither El Niño nor La Niña) ENSO Outlook Predicted to remain neutral with the possibility of reaching La Niña levels in the coming months.
